The year 2021 was also all about corona. The pandemic still brought uncertainties. During the year, the board of Alnaus maintained contact with the nuns from India to see where concrete help was needed. For the time being, there was no concrete need for help from the nuns. The board will continue to maintain contact with the nuns and as soon as it is possible they will resume a trip to Chennai to explore further cooperation options with the nuns.

As a result of the corona pandemic, tensions in personal spheres increased, which also increased domestic violence. This has led Alnaus to start a project to raise awareness of domestic violence, by giving victims of domestic violence the space to share their stories. Artists then translated the personal stories into works of art. The aim of the project is to sell the art objects, so that not only awareness is created for domestic violence, but the proceeds of the sales are also donated to cooperating organizations that are committed to girls and women who are victims of domestic violence. The project was rolled out in 2020 and has taken shape. The launch and further start of the project took place in 2021.
